

# **Mikumi 2 day Safari**

*This 2 day Itinerary is the perfect option for those looking for a cheap accessible safari. Commonly guests join on this safari before heading to or returning from Zanzibar.*

## **Day 1: Depart Dar and enter Mikumi**

It will be an early start, with only two days it's important we make the most of our time. Pickups will begin at your hotel from 6.00am and then it's out onto the western road heading towards Mikumi NP. Our route takes us out across the Uluguru Mountains, part of Eastern Arc Mountain Range. Following lunch we will head into the park for our first game drive. Mikumi NP abuts the northern border of Africa's biggest game reserve the Selous. This creates a 75 000 square kilometre wilderness tract that stretches almost to the Indian Ocean. Following the afternoon/evening game drive we will camp within the NP at Bastian Camp. Camping within the National Park is an incredible experience and being able to hear the noises of the wildlife from the safety of your camp is an experience that will stay with you.

## **Day 2: Morning game drive followed by return to Dar**

Following an early morning breakfast we will continue into the park for a morning game drive, this is the period where the wildlife is most active and gives us an opportunity to spot a diverse range of wildlife. The big 5 can be spotted within Mikumi NP as well as a variety of lesser-known game. Your game drive will take you deep into the Mkata Floodplain, with its endless horizons the Mkata Floodplain is known for the comparisons it draws with the more well known Serengeti NP. Following lunch, in the park, you will return to Dar es Salaam to be dropped off at your hotel around 7.00pm.
